

Pro bono opportunity with NRC:

NRC needs dev-ops assistance

The Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC) is in the midst of a digital transformation process and we are planning to develop several applications to provide a scalable and robust solution for private donor recruitment. In our next term, a strategic objective for NRC will be to increase private sector funding and this project will play a crucial role towards reaching this goal. With increased funding from the private sector, we can help more people who are forced to flee their homes.

For the development of several applications, NRC needs help developing, deploying, debugging and error handling on Kubernetes instance. The instance has Terraform implemented and must be utilised when deploying.

We are looking for someone with the right expertise to join our team which currently consists of one senior full stack developer, one junior developer, one senior consultant focusing on security and pipelines and one product owner/business analyst. The dev-ops team will conduct a specific onboarding onto our instance during the project kick-off. The following work will be planned using sprints and there will be weekly 10 mins check-ins.

Time frame:

We are looking for someone who can allocate roughly 50 hours across a six-months period starting in January 2022.

The work can be done remotely within the EEA with the possibility to work with the rest of the team from NRC's head office in Oslo if desired.

Desired outcomes/deliverables of the project:

Assistance with tasks related to developing, deploying, debugging, and error-handling on Kubernetes instance over a period of six months.

Qualifications and requirements:

We are looking for someone who has excellent knowledge of Kubernetes; experience using Terraform; and more than five years of dev-ops experience. Preferably also experience with test-driven development practices.
